

Those words were first written in the early 1500s, and that observation of gratitude and thankfulness remains relevant, even among majesty of a sunset, the mystery of starlit sky, the beauty of a yellow rose and the harmony of a special piece of music. We easily forget we have

Paston's Desk followers of Jesus. We often take for granted the freedom to worship where we please, and the liberty to voice our opinions without fear of the military knocking on our door in the middle of the night. By God's grace we are given the opportunity to experience the amazing love of His Son Jesus Christ. It seems that the more blessings we have, the less likely we are to thank God for them. Why is that?

There are many reasons, but perhaps the most obvious is that we simply forget that all that we have comes from God. Perhaps another reason is that we are just politely angry with God. No matter how blessed we are, tragedy or some other trial can cause us to be over-anxious and less than grateful. So how do we learn to be more thankful (and less anxious)? The answer to that question, as well as many other of life's difficult questions, is found in the Scriptures. For instance, in his letter to the church at Thessalonica, Paul reminds us that God's will in Christ for us as His followers is to do three things all the time every time: rejoice, pray, and give thanks.

Paul illustrates a basic biblical truth: we won't be anxious when we are being thankful. Think about that for a moment. If we are truly thankful to God for what we have, or what we are experiencing, or even for what we don't have, we can't be stressed out and anxious at the same time. It's true! Thankfulness brings us joy and peace.

As we prepare for our Thanksgiving celebrations this month, let us thank God in our prayers three ways. Let us say thanks for all that He has done for us in the past, for all that He is doing for us right at this moment, and for all that He will continue to do for us in the future. Let us thank Jesus for dying for us, praise Jesus for loving us, and rejoice because we have a place in eternity with Him. There is no greater gift than the love of Jesus. Nothing deserves our gratitude more. Be thankful and rejoice that Jesus loves you!
