One of the ways that God reveals His glory to us is through the changing of the seasons. March is here, and that means spring and Easter Sunday are only a few weeks away! The extra minutes of daylight that come with precision each day bring hope that the frigid temperatures of January and February will be nothing more than historical data that others will someday look back upon. God in His grace is the God of change and the God that never changes. That is eternally true, and we can trust Father, Son and Holy Spirit today just as our ancestors did thousands of years ago. In some ways we can trust God even more, for we too have historical data to refer to and look back upon. It may be found in the Scriptures, a trustworthy and true record of an unchanging God with an unchanging desire to change His people and make us holy.

The reality is that God's people need to change just as the seasons do. Just as we would not choose to wear a bathing suit and shovel the driveway or a heavy jacket and go swimming on the beach, we need to be keenly aware of the conditions of the world around us and react appropriately. The problem is that our world has changed and is changing so quickly that we often are unsure how to respond as loving Christians. When those emotions and feelings arise, it is good to remember that God wants us to change for the better, to become the people we were created and designed to be. Simply put, God desires us to become holy people. The process of holy change is a journey, and God has designed and decreed the church to be a necessary and integral part of it.

On that blessed walk to our Saviors side, there will be times when we will need to change with the seasons and other times when we dare not. Recognizing signs and seasons are critical in our journey to Christian perfection, and the Scriptures guide us and help us in doing so. Yet the reality is that there is a fifth season, the one we are living in at present. It is a season called heresy, an abandonment of established Scriptural principles. It is nothing new, and Acts 20:30 describes this unholy season this way: "some of your own people will distort the word in order to lure followers after them." Though the four seasons of the year are not mentioned in the Scriptures, heresy is. We are warned there in many places to recognize and beware of false prophets and false teachers. One way to recognize them is that they are preaching a different Gospel than the one God's people have known and loved for thousands of years.

Those who claim that the church must embrace and change with our culture rather than redeem it are preaching a different gospel. Though at times their message has great appeal, it is a gospel of false affection that does not lead to the path of holiness and righteousness. If something seems contrary to the Scriptures, it is worth examining further lest we lose our way. Let us remain steadfast and firm in our commitment to walking in truth and love!



MULTI-MEDIA AND AUDIO-VISUAL \$\$\$ CAMPAIGN

One positive outcome of Covid-19 is that we began new ways to reach those who are unable to be in our sanctuary for worship on Sunday mornings. We are now live streaming our worship service and publishing it on our website for viewing 24/7. It was necessary to purchase a video camera and upgrade the church internet service for that to happen. An audio/visual room is also needed at the rear of the sanctuary so that all of the necessary electronics and related equipment for local and streamed worship can be centrally located and secured when not in use. Thankfully, we received a \$500.00 Covid-19 grant from the Mahoning Valley United Methodist District Union to help with some of those expenses. However, it is not nearly enough. The additional cost for internet alone is over \$700.00 per year! Please consider making a special donation so that we can effectively reach new people for Jesus Christ.
