Love works here...... Those are three simple words, but when linked together, they become a powerful statement of faith and belief. It is a fitting description for the ministries of the Millcreek Community UM church, and there is no doubt that we believe it to be true. But If someone were to say to you "that is great, but what does it mean?", how would you respond? The problem is that each of those three words can mean many different things. Love is the most complex, and unfortunately the English language severely limits our understanding and use of the word. The ancient Greeks recognized six different kinds of love and then created words to go along with them. Three of them may sound familiar to us-Agape', which describes the love we have for God and the love God has for us; Eros, which implies intimacy or passion; and Philia, which describes the love we have for our fellow humans. The other three are not so well known. Storge describes the love for our family members (or even our favorite sports team!); Philautia means self -love, and Xenia, which refers to hospitality and love of strangers. Thank you, Wikipedia for that Greek language refresher course!

With that in mind, just what kind of "love" are we talking about when we say love works here? And when we say "works", does it mean labor and toil, or would it mean we are accomplishing a goal? When we say "here" does it mean 4570 Lockwood Blvd or some other place? It is quite likely that love works here will be interpreted and even understood differently, depending upon who is doing the asking and who is doing the answering! So, rather than offer a deep theological explanation, I have a suggestion. Let us simply say that love works here means that we are willing to set aside ourselves and our personal wants for the glory of the kingdom. Most of those six Greek words for love could be referred to in some way, as they will help us accomplish our goal and Biblical command to expand God's kingdom on earth. There are also a few that that can interfere with it. I trust we will recognize which ones they are.

Let *love* work here, love for God and love for neighbor. Let it *work*, both in our labors and our successes. Let it work here, at Millcreek and the world beyond our doors! *May* it continue to be true..... every month of the year! Pastor Greg
