The writer of the 12th chapter of Hebrews uses the imagery of a race or sporting event to describe our faith journey. "Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles, and let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us". For most of us, that race will be more of a marathon than a sprint. Running with perseverance means we won't give up before we reach the finish line. We stay in our lanes and anticipate the joy that comes when we finish the race. We also follow the rules. Can you imagine a ballgame without rules, markers, referees, or penalties? Might be fun to watch, but few of us would enjoy playing such an unfair game.

Race or ballgame, preparation is an important part of training for any athletic event. Good football teams become great football teams when they devote much time to practice and conditioning and study their opponents' strengths and weaknesses. It's much the same with our spiritual life. In verse 12:12-13, we are told to "strengthen our feeble arms and weak knees and make a level path for our feet". Simple things done consistently- prayer, fasting, Bible study, regular Sunday worship, reading Christian books and enjoying Christian music are an important part of the faith strengthening process. It is likely we won't reach the finish line without practicing those spiritual disciplines. This is not only for our benefit, but for those who may be watching us from a distance or following close behind. Never underestimate the influence you have on those God has placed in our path.

Perhaps the most important verse in the entire book of Hebrews is 12:14. "Strive for peace with everyone, and for the holiness without which no one will see the Lord". Can you imagine living in peace with all people? Holiness is not so much the lack of penalties or fouls, but how many points were scored and how many defensive plays were made. In other words, its not so much what we *don't* do, but what we *do* with our God given talents and abilities that leads us to the path of holiness. We do want to stay between the lines, play a mistake free game, and avoid fouling another player. We can't do that alone. Take a moment right now, acknowledge God's love and providence, and ask Him to fill you anew with His Spirit. If we are truly giving every last bit of ourselves, we will need that second wind. Take time to be holy! Pastor Greg


