You will now find a specific thing we as the church will pray for together, Monday through Saturday. On Sunday our prayer focus is Jesus as we begin a new week together in worship. The church calendar is so much more than a list of events. It is a list of opportunities to connect our families, neighbors and friends to Jesus. Let us make it a regular part of our prayer time. Who knows, it might spark ideas which lead to events, life-changing events!

SEPTEMBER MOMENTS

A moment in time, we celebrate Labor Day by "not working". But it replicates our week, we labor and then we rest. Mostly, on Labor Day, we honor the value of labor by putting it out of our thoughts for that extra long weekend. Peter S. McGuire is somewhat credited with coming up with the idea, however, recent research suggests the originator may in fact be Matthew Maguire, a labor union leader in 1882. Maguire suggested that this date would fall midway between July 4th and Thanksgiving. On June 28, 1894, President Grover Cleveland signed a law making the first Monday in September a legal National Holiday every year.

Moving along...September 6, 1995, Cal Ripkin Jr, of the Baltimore Orioles played in his 2,131st consecutive game to set a new record for Major League Baseball.

Marian McQuade hoped to establish a national day that would honor grandparents, and throughout the 1970's she brought awareness to the importance of senior citizens. In 1978, President Jimmy Carter declared the first Sunday after Labor Day to be National Grandparents Day. The National Grandparents Day Council chose the official flower as the "Forget-Me-Not Flowers" and Johnny Prill's "A Song for Grandma and Grandpa" the official song. No matter what, the best Grandparents Day is spending time together and celebrating your special relationship!

So bringing us back to our Moments at Millcreek Community Methodist Church, we chose the first Sunday of every month to celebrate Communion Sunday. It is a solemn moment for each of us to renew a closer union with Jesus Our Lord.

Every-other-month throughout the year we gather to prepare a Free Community Drive-Thru Dinner. This dinner requires many of us getting this meal together and making sure everything is added to the Dinner Box that we serve to the folks who come through the line.

Come September 14th, we will have an Outdoor Service, providing the September weather cooperates.
